



Stereotactic radiotherapy to the head

During the screening scan, a personalized mask will be made on your face to help you maintain position during treatment.

Important information

- ✕ Allow 1 hour 30 minutes during the identification scan, including a maximum of 45 minutes under the mask.
- ✕ Your treatment sessions (1 to 6 depending on the prescription) will be scheduled every 2 days.
- ✕ A treatment session lasts 20 to 30 minutes under the mask.

Side effects :

The side effects cited are not systematic.

- Possible hair loss observed in the irradiated area.
- Cerebral edema causing headaches, nausea, dizziness.

Inform your radiotherapist if you have headaches, nausea or dizziness so that he can readjust your corticosteroid dosage.

As soon as an unexplained side effect appears, talk to the radiographer or your radiotherapist.

Apply all these recommendations from the first radiotherapy session and for 3 weeks after the last session.
